
Below are the general Club rules:

1. Tennis attire and non-marking shoes must be worn on the courts.
2. Shirts must be worn at all times while on the Club premises.
3. Smoking or vaping is not allowed on the Club premises.
4. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on Club premises, except for events with LCBO permit.
5. Do NOT leave food wrappers, ball cans/lids, food waste behind on the courts. It is the responsibility of all members to keep the courts clean and tidy and to show respect for the property.
6. Children and pets must NOT enter the playing area and must NOT be left unattended or be disruptive to other players. Pets may NOT be tied to the Club fence or property.
7. Lawn chairs and coolers are not permitted on the courts. Please use available benches only for seating.
8. Members are expected to show courtesy and respect, and display good etiquette to all players, members, volunteers, facilitators and spectators at all times. Profane language (in any language), shouting and loud behavior is prohibited. Music speakers are not allowed with the exception of Club events as permitted by the Board.
9. Courts are to be used only when safely dry and cleared of debris.
10. The Club's property may not be used before the Club's spring opening when the nets are put up, or after the final closing when the last net is taken down.
11. Members must do all court bookings online via Court Reserve.
 - a. Online bookings can be done up to 7 days in advance.
 - b. Members are allowed one court booking per day
 - c. Allowable booking times for doubles are 60, 90 or 120 minutes. Single play is 60 minutes only.
 - d. Players who cannot make it to their booked period should log into the online booking system ahead of time and cancel the booking to free up the court for others.
 - e. Players must cancel bookings 4 hours ahead to avoid penalty.
 - f. Court Reserve bookings must be made manually, not using bots or code for bookings. If code/bots are used, membership will be terminated immediately and the individual banned from joining the Club in the future.
12. Court time may be claimed only when properly booked online.
 - a. The names on the online booking system must correspond to the playing arrangements on the courts, by time, by player, and by court.
13. Pickleball is allowed only between the hours of 9am and 10pm and will be strictly enforced.
14. Tennis is allowed between the hours of 7am and 11pm.
15. Court lights must be turned off by the last players leaving the court.
